WHAT IS REQUIRED TO REGISTER?



WHAT IS FINDING GOD TOGETHER?

Finding God Together is a family program designed to initiate children (3rd Grade and ^) and their families to the Catholic faith and sacramental life. Families will attend Finding God Together sessions and two sessions of GATHER (at the end of the year with the Finding God Together team). At Finding God Together, Parents attend the Adult Formation Sessions simultaneously to support their children's faith as well as grow in their own faith! At the end of the process, your child will receive the Sacrament of Baptism, Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, as needed. The following year, the family will continue to attend the GATHER Family Faith Formation sessions.

WHY IS FINDING GOD TOGETHER NEEDED?

We understand there are many reasons why a child has missed receiving the sacraments, Finding God Together provides the opportunity for "catching up" while still maintaining the grade level your child is in at GATHER Family Faith Formation.

The Roman Catholic Church teaches that children over the age of reason (7) cannot be baptized through the traditional infant ritual. The Church requires a period of instruction to prepare children for initiation into the Catholic faith.

Parents are the "first and primary teachers of the faith for their children". This program supports parents to confidently pass on the faith to their children.
